THE CANDID CONVERSATION GAME

CONTENTS:
100 cards, 2 dice



AGES
12+



SET UP:

- Shuffle the Cards.
 - For 3-5 players: Deal four Cards to each player face down.
 - For 6+ players: Deal three Cards to each player face down.
- Place the remaining Cards to the side.
- The player who has the most photos on their phone goes first. *(Now put your phones down and don't touch them until after the game.)*

HOW TO PLAY:

1. The first player rolls both Dice and flips **one** of their Cards face up. Each Card has two questions.
2. The first Die indicates **which** question the roller asks.
3. The second Die indicates **who** answers the question.

DIE 1:



x2: Read the question on the Purple side of the Card.



x2: Read the question on the White side of the Card.



x2: Read one question from either the Purple or White side.

DIE 2:



x2: The player to your Left answers the question.



x2: The player to your Right answers the question.



x1: All players answer the question.



x1: You answer the question.

4. After the question has been answered, play continues clockwise, and the next player rolls the Dice.
5. The game ends when all the Cards in play have been flipped face up.

WINNING:

We are all winners when we get to know each other a little better!

DICE ROLL EXAMPLES:

Example 1: Player 1 rolls these two symbols.

They flip one of their Cards face up and ask the purple question to the player on their Left.



Example 2: Player 2 rolls these two symbols.

They flip one of their Cards face up and ask the white question to All players.



Example 3: Player 3 rolls these two symbols.

They flip one of their Cards face up and ask either a purple or white question to the player on their Right.



Example 4: Player 4 rolls these two symbols.

They flip one of their Cards face up and answer the purple question themselves.
